

### AFFORDABLE CONNECTIVITY **PROGRAM HAS ENDED!**

#### To All Whom It Concerns/Affects:

Due to a lack of additional funding from Congress the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) has ended. Effectively as of June 1, 2024, participating households will no longer receive the monthly discount. ACP enrolled households are strongly encouraged to carefully review written notices from their internet company and from the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC), the ACP administrator, about the end of ACP and how your internet service bill will be impacted.

## Low-Income Home Energy Assistance

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a federally funded program that helps income-qualified families with home heating and cooling costs.

To be eligible, you must meet the following requirements:

- Have a total income no more than 60% of the Florida State Median Income
- Be responsible for paying your home heating or cooling bills
- Be a resident of Florida/Pinellas County
- Be a US Citizen, qualified alien, or permanent US resident
